In relation to our educators, we believe in building a strong team dynamic that encourages sharing ideas, and recognizing the different skills that each team member contributes to the Centre.

In regards to the program, the Centre works in collaboration with families, children and the community to deliver a tailor made educational program that is rich in meaningful experiences for your children.

Our educational program is play-based, with a strong emphasis on the children's interests. We use intentional teaching methods in play to help each child progress to their next area of development. Whilst customising play and learn according to your child's independent choices at our Centre.

Stimulated and inspired to explore, discover and grow. These are the words which come to mind when we think about early education at Little Learners

We have a strong belief in providing an educational program that encourages children to explore, create and investigate the world around them. Our program is centered around play- based learning, spontaneous experiences that derive from educator observations and children's interests and input from our families and community. We research and plan experiences that are thoughtful, meaningful and take into account children's age, abilities and strengths.

Our educators have strong and in-depth knowledge of The Early Years Learning Framework, which we use to guide our practices. The children are assessed against the five Quality areas each day through our educational program, as well as their monthly observations and mid-year and end of year reports. To ensure all children are catered for, we have an extensive planning cycle, that includes our educational program, observations, jottings, work samples and much more. Using these carefully thought after documents, educators work together to create portfolio's as well as an online journal for each child. Using a variety of method's, including, but not limited to learning stories, time samples, scripts, anecdotal records and much more, families gain great insight into how their children are growing and developing.

Throughout the year, the children are exposed to different methods of learning through the use of incursions. We arrange one per term and all differ in topics. In the past, we have had puppet shows, magic shows, reptile and under the sea explorations and multicultural shows, each with their own strengths and tailor made learning opportunities which are appropriate for our children.



A FOCUS ON HEALTH AND WELLBEING

Children, just like adults, sometimes need extra assistance in their learning and development. Through acknowledging this, we can better care for the children within our care who may need access to other services.

We employ the use of a speech pathologist, who can measure and diagnose possible speech delays. Speech therapy is then offered at the centre, making the routine for children and families easier and less stressful.

The centre takes part in the STEPS vision examination each year, allowing families of children who are aged four and up, to have

- their eyes tested for free. Based on these examinations parents can then be referred for further assistance if required.
- Along with these great health services, we also employ the use of early intervention services, such as KU and SDN.
- Through accessing early intervention, we gain assistance in identifying additional methods/ resources/ services that will help give children the best start to their education and to life.



GETTING ACTIVE!

Here at The Hills Little Learners we take pride in getting children active and teaching them the importance of a healthy, well balanced life style.

Through our outdoor program, we engage the children in both planned and spontaneous experiences that promote physical activity and skills, including:

- Balance and coordination
- Wellbeing
- Flexibility
- Climbing
- Catching and throwing and much more

Weekly Yoga classes are conducted, a long with our 'Munch and Move' program, that encourages children to eat well and get active. We focus on developing the children's fundamental movement skills through games, sporting activities and during every day routines.

We also provide access to two different sporting classes that are run during the week; a soccer class and a dance class. These extracurricular classes allow children to explore different skills and engage with a range of resources.

OUR LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

Our learning environments are well thought out spaces that encourage children to explore, create and investigate. We regularly update our learning spaces to cater for our children's growing strengths, interests, skills and our educational program goals.

We aim to provide an environment that is rich is natural elements, allowing the children the autonomy to freely explore their surroundings, both indoors and outdoors. Our natural learning spaces create a calming atmosphere for the children to explore.

The safety of your children is paramount. We have a visual security doorbell, safety gates, shaded play areas and a well-maintained building rich in resources that help to create a safe environment for your child.

Our Educators work towards embedding sustainable practices into every day routines and learning. We incorporate the use of our veggie garden, compost bin and rain water tank each day, whilst also regularly working on water conservation, recycling, using natural items for play experiences and more.



PARTNERSHIPS WITH PARENTS AND THE COMMUNITY

We believe relationships with families make a tremendous difference to how well a child lourishes. The nurturing circle between the child, the parent and the Educator is valued and encouraged.

We promote family involvement on many levels, whether it's directly contributing to your child's learning or participating in events we hold throughout the year. We hold regular social events where you will meet other families and celebrate with your children.
